HOMEMAKING SERVICES

Council on Aging employs several homemakers who are available to help seniors with dishwashing, laundry, bill paying, grocery shopping and other daily jobs, in addition to offering a friendly person to visit with or a chance for caretakers to take a much-needed break. Council on Aging works with State Health Insurance Assistance Program, counselors trained in helping clients with Medicare, Social Security and related issues. Services are available to those over age 60, as well as the disabled, with a suggested donation rate of \$8.50 per hour.

MEAL SITES

Provides meals that meet the requirements of the Older Americans Act of 1965 at five different sites. Suggested donation is \$3.50 for people 60 or older and \$4.50 for those under 60.

Lewistown: Lunch is served at the Council on Aging (Grubstakes), Monday through Friday at 12 noon. Home delivered meals are also available for home bound seniors. Suggested donation for home delivered meals is \$4.

Telephone/Cell Phone Assistance

Lifeline is a government program that provides a monthly discount on home or mobile telephone services. Only one Lifeline discount allowed per household. Members of a household are not permitted to receive Lifeline services from multiple telephone companies. The household income must be under 135% of federal poverty guidelines to meet eligibility.

To register contact a local telephone company (eligible companies are found at www.lifelinesupport.org) Local companies participating include 3 Rivers, Mid-Rivers, Triangle Communications, Central Montana Communications, Cellular One.

Recognizing the important benefits associated with phone access and concerned that low-income households may not be able to afford phone service on their own, the federal government created the Lifeline Assistance program in 1985. Consumers who qualify based on federal or state-specific eligibility criteria can obtain discounted or free phone service through the Lifeline Assistance program.

This program has expanded and now includes cell phones (data, minutes, and texting). The service is provided through Assurance wireless and Q Link Wireless.
